SCHOLARSHIPS

All applications are available in the self-serve drawers in the guidance office. Students may stop down before school, during tutorial, lunch, or after school to pick up applications.

GM Band Boosters' John J. Marszalek Scholarship - Criteria include: participation in band for at least 3 years, including musicians, color guard and managers. Applicant must be pursuing further education at either a 2 yr. or 4 yr. school. Two monetary awards will be distributed. Deadline is May 1, 2007.

The Mechanical Contractors Association of NW PA - Two \$500 scholarships to a senior student enrolling in a plumbing, HVAC, mechanical engineering, or construction related field. Application forms can be picked up in the guidance office or can be downloaded at www.mcanwpa.com. Deadline is May 1st.
